The Presentation of Elizabeth Grace for Baptism. Katiegrace Dudley (Mother) & Ellen Elizabeth & Michael Newman (Godparents)

Celebrant The Candidate for Holy Baptism will now be presented.

Parent and Godparents I present Elizabeth Grace to receive the

Sacrament of Baptism.

Celebrant Will you be responsible for seeing that the

child you present is brought up in the

Christian faith and life?

Parent and Godparents I will, with God's help.

Celebrant Will you by your prayers and witness help this

child to grow into the full stature of Christ?

Parent and Godparents I will, with God's help.

p302 (BCP)

Then the Celebrant asks the following questions of the parent and godparents speaking for Elizabeth Grace.

Question Do you renounce Satan and all the spiritual forces of

wickedness that rebel against God?

Answer I renounce them.

Question Do you renounce the evil powers of this world which

The Celebrant addresses the assembly, saying

Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support this person in her life in Christ?

Celebrant Do you believe in God the Father?

People I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Celebrant Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?People I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord.

He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of

the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was

crucified, died, and was buried.

He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again.

He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the

living and the dead.

Celebrant Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

People I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy

catholic Church, the communion of

saints, the forgiveness of sins,

the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.

Celebrant Will you continue in the apostles' teaching and fellowship,

in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers?

People I will, with God's help.

Celebrant Will you persevere in resisting evil, and, whenever you fall

into sin, repent and return to the Lord?

People I will, with God's help.

Celebrant Will you proclaim by word and example the Good News of God in

Christ?

People I will, with God's help.

Celebrant Will you seek and serve Christ in all persons, loving your neighbor as

yourself?

People I will, with God's help.

Celebrant Will you strive for justice and peace among all people, and

respect the dignity of every human being?

People I will, with God's help.

Prayers for the Candidate p305 (BCP)

Celebrant Let us now pray for *Elizabeth Grace* who is to receive the Sacrament of new birth.

Leader Deliver her, O Lord, from the way of sin and death.

People Lord, hear our prayer.

Leader Fill her with your holy and life-giving Spirit.

People Lord, hear our prayer.

Leader Keep her in the faith and communion of your holy Church.

People Lord, hear our prayer.

Leader Teach her to love others in the power of the Spirit.

Thanksgiving over the Water p306 (BCP)

Celebrant The

Lord be with you.

People And

also with you.

Celebrant Let us give thanks to

the Lord our God.

People It is right to give God

thanks and praise.

Celebrant

We thank you, Almighty God, for the gift of water. Over it the Holy Spirit moved in the beginning of creation. Through it you led the children of Israel out of their bondage in Egypt into the land of promise. In it your Son Jesus received the baptism of John and was anointed by the Holy Spirit as the Messiah, the Christ, to lead us, through his death and resurrection, from the bondage of sin into everlasting life.

We thank you, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in his death. By it we share in his resurrection. Through it we are reborn by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to your Son, we bring into his fellowship those who come to him in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

At the following words, the Celebrant touches the water.

Now sanctify this water, we pray you, by the power of your Holy Spirit, that those who here are cleansed from sin and born again may continue for ever in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Savior. To him, to you, and to the Holy Spirit, be all honor and glory, now and for ever. Amen.

The Baptism p307 (BCP)

The Celebrant pours water upon the candidate, saying:

Elizabeth Grace, I baptize you in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Celebrant Let us pray.

Heavenly Father, we thank you that by water and the Holy Spirit you have bestowed upon this your servants the forgiveness of sin, and have raised her to the new life of grace. Sustain her, O Lord, in your Holy Spirit. Give her an inquiring and discerning heart, the courage to will and to persevere, a spirit to know and to love you, and the gift of joy and wonder in all your works. Amen.

Celebrant Let us welcome the newly baptized!

People We receive you into the household of God. Confess the faith of Christ

crucified, proclaim his resurrection, and share with us in his

eternal priesthood.

Celebrant The peace of the Lord be always with you!

People And also with you!

Celebrant Let us go forth in the name of Christ.

People Thanks be to God!
